Regular Council Meeting

September 28, 2011

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Pro Tem Gilbert called to order the Regular Council meeting of September 28, 2011.

ROLL CALL: Council members T. Summers, D. McQueen, B. Thawsh and S. Haubrich were present.

Approval of the Regular Council Meeting minutes for September 14, 2011

Councilmember Summers made a motion to approve the Regular Meeting minutes for September 14, 2011. Councilmember Haubrich seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Bills for September 28, 2011 as budgeted

Councilmember McQueen made a motion to approve the bills for September 28, 2011 as budgeted. Councilmember Summers seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Ordinance No. 2011.06 Incorporating Pierce County's animal ordinance
Councilmember Haubrich made a motion to accept Ordinance No. 2011.06, an ordinance of the Town of Wilkeson, Pierce County, Washington incorporating by reference Pierce County Ordinance 2011-43s amending Title 6 of Pierce County Code, animals, and incorporating by reference Title 6 of the Pierce County Code, animals. Councilmember Summers seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
2. No parking sign on Short and Cothary, also on Albert Street
There have been traffic safety concerns due to parking on the corner at Short and Cothary. Council discussed placing a "no parking" sign on this corner but decided to table the item until next meeting when more information could be made available. Council also discussed the parking on Albert Street. No parking signs have been placed on Albert Street but there have been some complaints about citizen's still parking on both sides of the street making it difficult for emergency vehicles to navigate. Council decided to table this until next meeting when the Mayor would be present.
