

Basic Home Kit

- Water for 7 to 10 days**
1 gallon per person per day for drinking and sanitation
- Food for 7 to 10 days**
Supply of non-perishable food per person
- Cash**
ATMs may not be working; small bills are best
- Flashlight and extra batteries**
- Battery-powered radio and extra batteries**
- First aid kit**
- Whistle**
To signal for help
- Sturdy shoes, gloves**
- Shelter items**
Tent, tarp, rope
- Filter masks**
Or cotton T-shirts to help filter air
- Utility shut-off tool**
Water, natural gas
- Moist towelettes**
For sanitation
- Garbage bags / ties**
For personal sanitation
- Manual can opener**
For any canned food items
- Unique family needs**
Supplies for infants, pets; prescriptions, emergency phone numbers and important documents

Basic Car Kit

- Portable water and non-perishable food**
Bottled/package water – 64ozs per person per day; food bars - high protein/high energy
- Flashlight and extra batteries**
- Whistle**
To signal for help
- Cell phone charger**
- First aid kit**
- Emergency flares**
- Multi-purpose tool**
- Paper, pen & map**
If you must leave your car, be sure to leave a note to tell others your plan
- Extra clothing**
Sturdy shoes, socks, hat, gloves, rain gear/poncho
- Blanket**

Basic Office / Work Kit

- Water**
64oz per person per day
- Non-perishable food**
Food bars - high protein/high energy
- Flashlight and extra batteries**
- Whistle**
To signal for help
- Multipurpose tool**
- Personal hygiene / sanitation items**
- Extra clothing**
Sturdy shoes, socks, hat, gloves
- Blanket**
- Extra prescription medicine, contact supplies or spare glasses**
