PET LICENSING FEES

Dogs

Altered \$20*/Un-altered \$55
Un-altered Juvenile Dog [9 weeks
to 6 months] \$10

Cats

Altered \$12*/Un-altered \$55
Un-altered Juvenile Cat [9 weeks
to 6 months] \$6

Reduced Rates for Owners 62+

Dogs: Altered \$10*/Un-altered
\$30/Juvenile \$10
Cats: Altered \$5/Un-altered \$30/
Juvenile \$6

For new licenses, proof of alteration must be attached in order to receive this rate. You can obtain proof from the vet who performed the surgery. **Renewals do not need to include proof.*

Penalty for Failure to License:

First Offense ----- \$50.00
Second Offense ----- \$75.00
Third Offense ----- \$100.00
Fourth Offense and each offense
thereafter ----- \$200.00

Are you Breaking the Law?

Did you know....if you have a resident pet, (dog or cat) that is not licensed with Wilkeson Town Hall, you are breaking the law?

The Town of Wilkeson has an Animal Control License Ordinance in effect. This ordinance has been in effect since 2012.

Ordinance 2012.03 states that "It is unlawful for any person to own, keep, harbor, or have control of an animal (dog or cat) over the age of four (4) months in the Town without a license attached to the collar or halter of the dog. A license shall not be transferable."

Wilkeson currently has ONLY fourteen (14) pets (cats and dogs) licensed, to date, on the roster. We are aware there are many more pets, in residence, in the Town of Wilkeson.

These fees are imperative in order to help us maintain our contract with officers who provide to us our animal control service.

License applications may be obtained from Town Hall (Call us, we'll mail you one out.), or you can download them from our website. (www.townofwilkeson.com/business/forms-and-applications/)



When a license is purchased, it is good for one (1) year from date of issuance.

So come on.....don't make your pet a criminal.
Get that license!
