

Voters in the Town of Wilkeson have historically supported Emergency Medical Services (EMS) by authorizing EMS specific levies. In 2017, Town Voters authorized a "Permanent Lid Lift" with the goal of maintaining levy rates year to year.

However, this was not the case, and the amount has fallen from the limit of \$.50/\$1000 assessed value (AV) to roughly \$.30/\$1000 AV.

The proposed EMS levy would increase the amount back to \$.50/\$1000 av, and include up to 6% increases annually, with the goal of maintaining the maximum of \$.50/\$1000 av.

If this levy is approved, it will allow the Town of Wilkeson to continue to fund the cost of providing emergency medical care and services within the town.
